Bullying affects everyone.

Bullying can negatively affect children and young people's physical health, mental health, social development and academic achievement. Often dismissed as an unpleasant part of growing up, research shows bullying is a learned behaviour and harmful to the development of all involved – the initiators, targets and bystanders who witness it.

What is bullying?

Bullying is a word that can have a lot of different meanings for different people.

- Bullying is deliberate – harming another person intentionally.
- Bullying involves a misuse of power in a relationship.
- Bullying is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated over time.

Bullying can be verbal, physical and/or social; it can happen in person or online; and it can be obvious (overt) or hidden (covert).

Not every unkind thing is bullying.

Students, especially young children, are still learning how to get along with others.

They need parents, teachers and other adults to model kindness, inclusion, conflict resolution and responsibility. Single incidents and conflict or fights between equals, whether in person or online, are not defined as bullying. These behaviours may be just as upsetting and serious, but may need to be dealt with in a different way.

Does your child know who they would be able to talk to if they had a problem or if they needed to ask for help?
