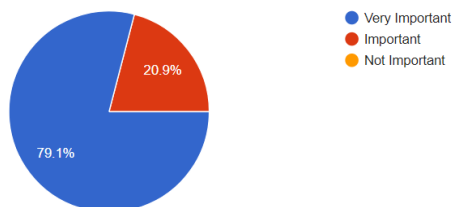

Thanks to all the people who took time to respond and share their thoughts with us. The following information will be used to inform future school policies and procedures.

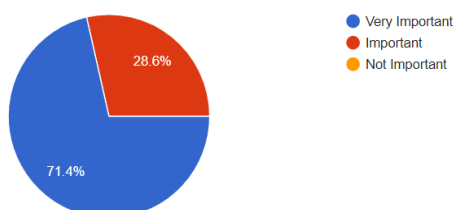
1. How important do you think Health and Physical Education is in the school programme?

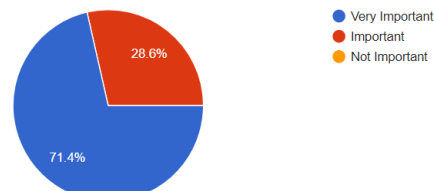

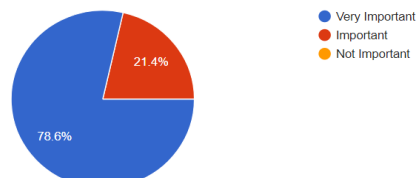

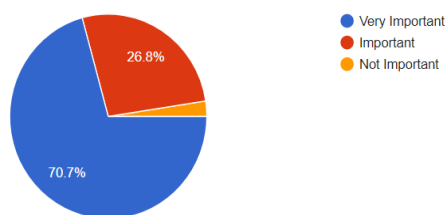

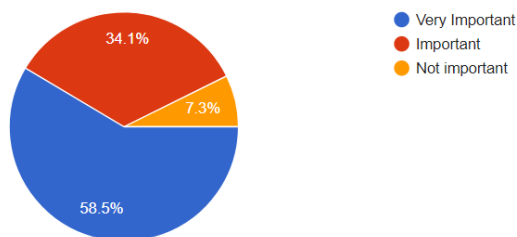

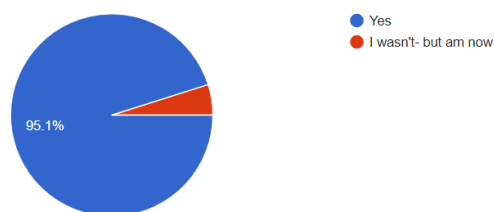
7. How important is school camp?

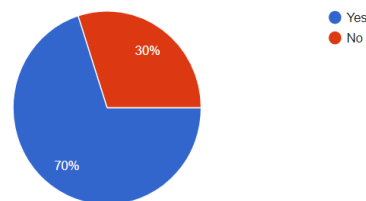

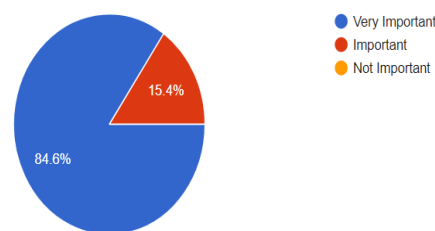

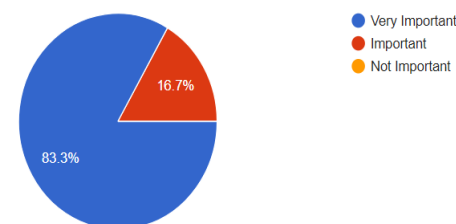
8a. The school operates a Sun Safe Policy. How important is being sun safe to your family?
