This year's theme is: **'Kia Kaha te Reo Māori'**

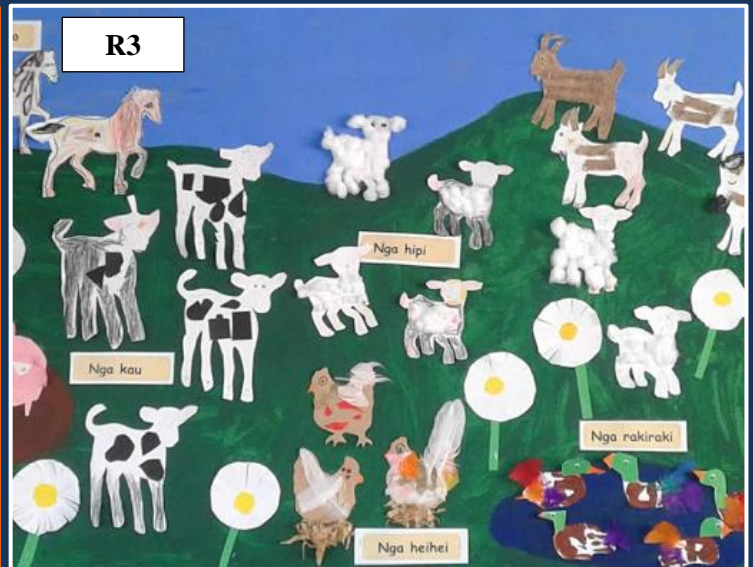
Translation: 'Let's make the Māori language strong'.

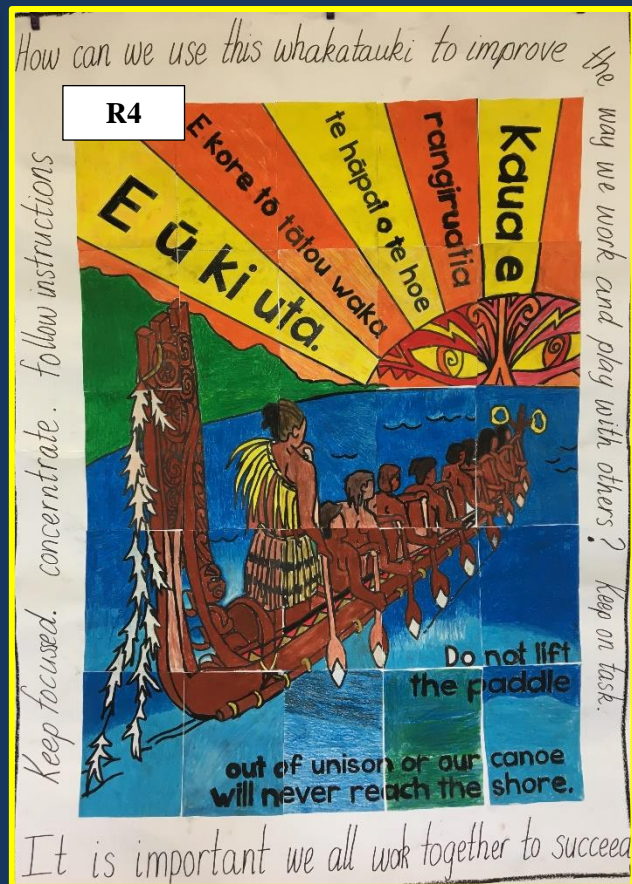
