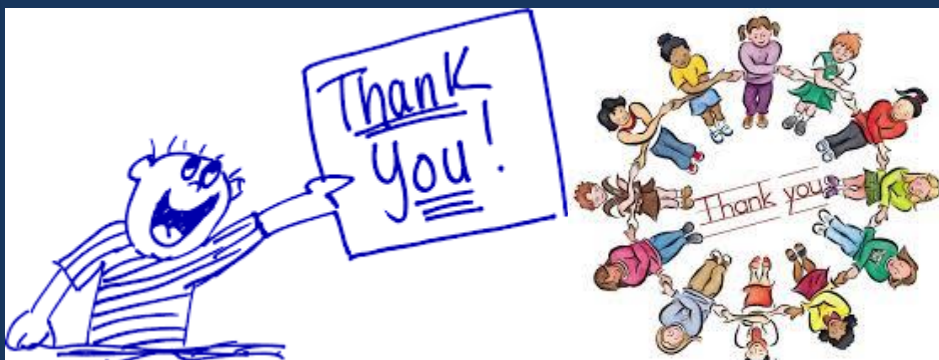
Our vision: Waipipi Students are successful learners, who communicate confidently and interact positively with others.
